Continuing Professional Development

I am currently studying with Compass Education and Training: Canine Nutrition certificate and a Pet Sitting Diploma. I have further Canine Nutrition courses lined up.

I have and continue to study various Scentwork training methods (Talking Dogs Scentwork & Scentwork UK). I am currently listed as a Scentwork UK Level 1-4 Recognised Trainer. I also aim to gain my CAP3 (Clicker Assessment program) – Level 3. I have run Fun Flygility classes and currently run Scentwork for Fun classes. I have recently passed my Puppy/Adult Pet Dog obedience classes to a colleague due to winding down my class work.

Though I am no longer pursuing studies to Level 6 for CAB accreditation, I have decided to concentrate on enhancing for my own training expertise and interests (canine nutrition and increasing the variety of services (e.g. general Pet Sitting, in future) and knowledge that I can offer clients alongside my Training and Behaviour work.

As a result of being assessed over the years and gaining Full membership of the APDT and TCBTS I am listed with the Animal Behaviour and Training Council as a 'Registered Animal Training Instructor' and an 'Accredited Animal Behaviourist' meeting the required ABTC standards for these roles.
